It is hard to believe that we are already into the month of October this week. So many wonderful things have occurred in this first month of school. Back to School Night was well attended by families, which speaks to the engaged and supportive community we belong to at Beverly Cleary. We heard from families that you appreciated having more time with your child's teacher and many of you signed up for a parent-teacher conference. You may have heard at Back to School night that Beverly Cleary has made some changes in our practices this year. As we grow into a stronger K-8, we are constantly looking for ways to improve our program. This year we are implementing Walk to Read at grades 1-3. First and third grade have already started Walk to Read and second grade will begin soon. This is a way to group students to ensure that we are meeting their rate and level in reading. Another class that started in late September is the fifth and sixth grade Beginning Band. At this point we have over 40 students enrolled in band! If you have questions about band feel free to contact Laura Boitano, our instructor. She is at Beverly Cleary every afternoon.

Speaking of walking, we are looking for parent volunteers to help with Safety Patrol before (8:25-8:45) and after (2:55-3:15) school. After a few close calls, we have decided that the crossing at 33<sup>rd</sup> and Hancock is too dangerous to have only students on patrol. We will need to have an adult with them. At this point Doug McMahon, Angela McMahon and Victor Gonzalez have been on duty nearly every day. We need more parents to help out. If we don't have adults, we will not send students out to patrol the crosswalk alone. Our goal is to keep all our kids safe and to provide one crosswalk that is monitored for families to cross 33<sup>rd</sup> safely. Another safety issue that arises at the beginning of school is volunteer background checks. Please check with Rosanne or Kelly to determine if you have a current background check on file with the district. Background checks must be done prior to volunteering at school. They are good for three years. We love the support our parents provide and are looking forward to logging many volunteer hours this year.

## Beverly Cleary School Foundation NEWS

- This year, students will have the opportunity to explore the world through a **geography program called The Passport Club**. Each child who participates will receive a passport, choose their individual level of study and collect postage stamps as they learn some or all the world's countries over the course of the school year.

The program thrives on parent volunteers so please consider giving us a hand. We are looking for **12** volunteer "checkers" from 1:00-3:00 on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday every month. "Checkers" listen as the students point to countries they have learned that month. Parents find this experience rewarding, and most appreciate learning current geography right along with their children.

On the back of the "monthly study map" you'll find an explanation of the Passport Club levels. This will help you discuss with your child which level they would be most interested in learning about. Additionally, very soon your child will receive some reference and study maps and a passport (that stays in the classroom). You can expect monthly communication from us about the parts of the world we will be learning each month.

This is a voluntary, self-study program designed to encourage young people's interest in geography through the collection of beautiful country-specific stamps given out during the once monthly check day. Please take time to encourage your child to participate.

Passport club is only possible with the help of parent volunteers. We will need at least 2 parents per class to volunteer on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of the month for "check day" from 1:00-3:00 pm. The following Fridays are on the schedule:

## **Beverly Cleary School TAG News**

- **Last week all TAG students in grades K-5 should have brought a letter and survey home in backpacks.** These letters and surveys were mailed home for students in grades 6, 7 and 8. The letter explains that teachers will be using the building TAG plan as a guide to determine which instructional strategies to use to meet your child's need for rate and level. A copy of Beverly Cleary's TAG plan can be found in the main office. Additionally, teachers talked about their assessment practices and differentiation strategies at Back to School Night. If you have a student who is identified as TAG, please return the survey to your child's teacher.

### **Important Dates for TAG**

- The **Grant Cluster TAG Parent Meeting** will be held at **Grant High from 6:30-8:00, October 14.** School-specific breakout meetings will be held immediately following the general meeting. All Grant Cluster TAG families are encouraged to attend.

**October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2009** – All Beverly Cleary second grade students will be given the NNAT screening test. This is a non-verbal screening instrument for possible TAG identification. Since this assessment does not screen for reading or math, parents and teachers will still need to make nominations.

**November 23rd, 2009** – Deadline for TAG Identification Process Forms (IDPF) to be submitted to schools. These nomination forms may be submitted by a teacher or a parent and can be found in the main office.

**January 2010** – Testing will be scheduled by the district TAG office. School teams have two weeks after testing to meet with their Leadership team and make recommendations.

**February 2010** – PPS sends a notification letter to families approximately 30 days after testing.

Genres include: Adventure, Animal Stories, Fantasy/Science Fiction, Historical Fiction, Mystery, and Realistic Fiction. (Reading levels are taken from Accelerated Reader [http://www.renlearn.com/store/quiz\\_advanced.asp](http://www.renlearn.com/store/quiz_advanced.asp)). The first number indicates grade level, the second the number of months after entering that grade.
