Here are a few tips that you might find helpful in preparing for your child's conference:

- Make sure you know the scheduled time for your conference
- Find out how your child feels about school (ask what he/she likes best or least and why).
- Come prepared with specific questions for the teacher about your child's work.
- Ask about how your child is progressing academically and socially.

-Listen as the teacher is sharing information about your student's progress.

-After the conference, share the information with your child.

-Most importantly, relax! We have a great staff that really takes the education of your children very seriously. They are committed to working with you!

The Beverly Cleary School, Fernwood campus, will be holding auditions for the play, "Ramona Quimby" by Beverly Cleary for all interested 6th, 7th and 8th grade students. The auditions will take place on Tuesday, December 1st and Wednesday, December 2nd immediately after school in the Fernwood cafeteria.

Interested students may sign up outside the school office to audition. If you do not sign up and are still interested in auditioning, you may come to tryouts and you may audition if time permits.

Those auditioning will be reading from the script at the time of auditions. If you want to familiarize yourself with the parts, try reading the book, RAMONA QUIMBY as the play sticks pretty closely to the story. The play has 14 speaking roles plus numerous nonspeaking roles. Students interested in working backstage and/or building sets may come to the auditions and fill out a form indicating that interest.

Finally, the play requires that actors participate in all rehearsals which will take place on most Tuesdays and Thursdays after school until 4:45 and more the week before the performance. A matinee/dress rehearsal will be performed for the school on Wednesday, February 24 in the afternoon and the

- It's time for **Art Cards!** If you are not familiar with them, they are lovely note cards made with images of your child's art work on them. Further, if you have seen some art in your child's classroom that you think would work well for this purpose, you can ask the

teacher if you can borrow the piece for about a month. They generally keep the work to display at the art nights in the spring, but they would probably be willing to lend you a piece.

- **Out With the Old, In With the New:** Beverly Cleary School will be hosting our second annual book donation drive for the **Children's Book Bank**, November 16 - 20. Please bring books - baby books, board books, Spanish books, story books, animal books, etc. to school during that week to drop in the donation boxes. Boxes will be located in the lobby at Hollywood and at Fernwood in the 2nd grade corridor and across from the library. (Please no coloring/activity books or textbooks.) This book drive takes place the week before the Scholastic Book Fair, and is timed perfectly for you to clear some space on your bookshelves for your new books!

In homes in middle-income neighborhoods, the ratio of books to children is 13 books for every child. In low-income neighborhoods the ratio is *1 book for every 300 children*. The mission of the Children's Book Bank is to support early family literacy and improve kindergarten reading readiness by providing a personal collection of books for each at-risk preschooler in Portland. The Children's Book Bank collects, sorts, cleans and distributes donations of new and used children's books in order to close the book gap that exists for children in low income families. - Does your student need help in math? Do you need a reference book? The PTA is selling two math reference books for upper grade use. Math on Call, for grades 6 – 8th, assists the student in homework, test review, daily assignments, and cooperative learning. Important Dates for TAG

November 23rd, 2009 – Deadline for TAG Identification Process Forms (IDPF) to be submitted to schools. These nomination forms may be submitted by a teacher or a parent and can be found in the main office.

January 2010 – Testing will be scheduled by the district TAG office. School teams have two weeks after testing to meet with their Leadership team and make recommendations.

February 2010 – PPS sends a notification letter to families approximately 30 days after testing.
